



YOU WILL NEED:

- 1 or 2 pieces of card
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Coloured Pencils



WHY CATS?

Florence Nightingale loved animals, her first 'patient' was a sheepdog called Cap. She had lots of pets during her life, 2 tortoises, an owl, a dog, a cicada and... OVER 60 CATS! Alongside nursing, animals and books were some of her favourite things!

STEP 1



Cut out the template or cut a strip of card. You can then cut the top into the shape of ears.

STEP 2



Cut another piece of card the same width as the cats body and cut out two paw shapes- these paws will hold on to the page of your book. You might also want to cut out 2 more paws or a tail!

STEP 3



Now glue to top of your paws to your cat body- make sure to only glue the top strip of paper and not the whole paw so they can hold on to your book page!



STEP 4

You can now use any spare paper and coloured pencils to decorate your cat. When the glue is dry you cat should sit happily in a book with its paws holding the page.
