## **YOU WILL NEED:**

- Black Card
- Owl Template
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Large Piece of Clear Cellophane
- Coloured
   Cellophane
   (sweet wrappers work well!)

#### WHY AN OWL?

Florence Nightingale rescued a small owl who was being attacked. She looked after the owl and loved it a lot, she named her 'Athena' and would carry her around in special pockets added to her dresses.

The real Athena is on display at the museum.

#### STEP 1



Print out the template and stick it to a piece of black card.

Carefully cut out the template, you might want a grown up to help you here as it can be fiddly!

#### STEP 2



Stick your cut out template to a piece of clear cellophane.

Turn it over so the cellophane is underneath the template.

#### STEP 3



Now stick small coloured pieces of cellophane on top to create your stained glass effect.

Try and cover it all so none of the clear cellophane can be seen.

### STEP 4



Once you have finished leave the glue to dry.
When it is all dry cut around the edge of the template to cut off any extra cellopahane.
Hold up to a window to see the light shine through!
